His name is Gary Kluch, who is Quality First Home Improvement, Inc. Ceo/Chairman of the Board, from Citrus Heights. He is a friend of Senator Ted Gaines of the First District in Sacramento.

Gary Kluch stated that we should get in touch with Ted Gaines about the problem of the low water. He ask if he could make a call, his call was to Ted Gaines. He put him on the speaker phone and told him a few things that were being discussed at our meeting and Ted Gaines said he would see if he could give us help from Sacramento.

Gary Kluch keep asking questions of Val and Rebecca and so they showed him so pictures of the fish kill last winter and all the people who had been contacted before and

they had all retired, or been moved to another area. They showed him a letter from Gary Stacy of Fish & Game that was an opinion that had no data or facts. Showed him pictures of dead fish, also make him copies of lots of the stuff they had collected, told him about the low PH, in the water that is too low for the fish to survive. He stated we should set up a meeting with Lahontan, Senator Ted Gains, Fish & Game, BLM, State Clean Water Board, Ranchers, Board of Supervisors of Lassen County, USFS, and Autobahn people who are interested in the Gibbs population breeding in the tullies.

Rebecca reported that using benzonite in Pine Creek to divert water to Silver Lake and elsewhere away from Eagle Lake.
